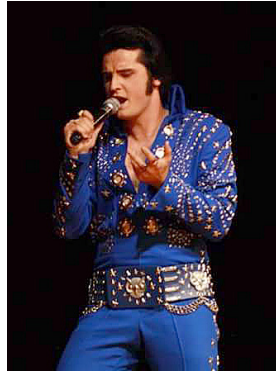

Leo Days

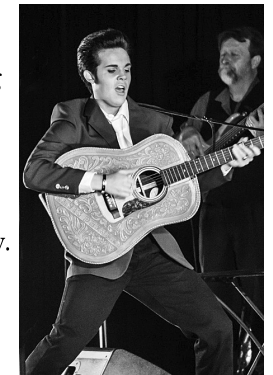
